DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply only as directed during the growing season. Apply when a regular feeding of nitrogen, phosphate and potassium along with sulfur is desired.

APPLICATION RATES

- LIGHT: 3.0 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.
- MEDIUM: 4.0 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.
- HEAVY: 5.0 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.

For all applications, apply to dry foliage. Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches of water to help move particles into the turf canopy. Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Cool-Season Grasses:

- Apply at the LIGHT or NORMAL RATE.
- Exception: apply at the LIGHT RATE when temperatures exceed 80°F.

Warm-Season Grasses:

- Apply at the NORMAL or HEAVY RATE .
- Exception: Apply at the NORMAL RATE when temperatures exceed 90°F.

Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing. Use only clean, dry spreaders. Do not leave unused product in spreaders.
