MICROYL is a unique activator adjuvant that provides superior performance and improved turfgrass safety at lower use rates when compared to ordinary crop oil concentrates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE WITH PESTICIDES REGISTERED FOR GOLF COURSES, SOD FARMS, RECREATIONAL, COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL TURFGRASS AREAS, AS WELL AS SPORTS GRASS PLAYING SURFACES AND NONCROPLAND.

The addition of adjuvants to some pesticides and/or fertilizers and their tank mixes may cause phytotoxicity to the foliage and/or fruit of desirable crops. Before using MICROYL, the applicator or crops advisor must have experience with the pesticide combination, including MICROYL, or must have conducted a phytotoxicity test.

Do not use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling. MICROYL increases the activity of many pesticides; therefore, care must be taken when treating sensitive crops during periods of drought stress, high temperatures or high humidity.

USE RATES

Apply at .375 - .5% v/v
(3-4 pints of MICROYL per 100 gallons of spray solution)

MIXING

Always mix this product in accordance with the instructions found on the pesticide label concerning adjuvants.

In the absence of specific mixing instructions, fill the spray tank 1/2 to 3/4 full of desired water volume. While the water is agitating, add tank mix ingredients in the following order:

1. If foaming is anticipated, use an antifoam/defoamer such as GUNDOWN™ or KNOCKDOWN™
2. Ammonium sulfate, fertilizers and micronutrients
3. Water-soluble packets, dry flowables and dispersible granule pesticides
4. Flowable pesticides
5. Water-soluble pesticides
6. Emulsifiable concentrate pesticides
7. Add MICROYL to the spray solution last and continue agitation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not use, spill or store near heat or open flame. Keep container closed tightly when not in use. Prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container. Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of container in a safe manner in accordance with federal, state and local regulations.
