This slow release nitrogen product provides a flat, even feed to the turf resulting in outstanding turf color and density in all types of weather. Plus, this non-phosphorus product is ideal in environmentally sensitive areas inclusive of wetlands and waterways. Sanctuary 10-0-10 can be applied safely throughout the growing season at a wide range of nitrogen rates. This all-season product delivers the turf nutrients essential for excellent growth, color and turf density.

Directions for Fairway Maintenance Programs: Apply 10 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. for 10 to 12 weeks of residual color. This product is ideal for applications adjacent to lakes and waterways where phosphorus run-off is a concern.

Directions for Late Fall Application: Apply 10 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. as a late fall rate for winter stress tolerance and spring color.

Directions for Environmental Greens Program: Apply 5 to 10 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. after spiking or slicing the greens where phosphorus run-off into waterways is a concern.

Directions for Hot Weather Stress Programs: Apply 3 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. on a 14-day interval during hot weather as an aid to stress and disease management programs.

Spreader settings are an initial guideline for calibrating the spreader.

Watering Directions

The product can be applied to wet or dry or stressed turf without any problems. For product breakdown, the key is WET – DRY – MOW. The product is applied and lightly watered – one cycle or revolution of the irrigation head. These products have a sugar binder. It is held together by sugars under pressure from the manufacturing process. The water aids in dissolving the sugar and releasing the pressure. The granular will begin to swell as the product dries. The product is ready to mow when dry to touch. It is recommended to mow without baskets to avoid picking up the product. For shorter mowing heights, a lower application rate at more frequent intervals is recommended. A dew whip can enhance breakdown and speed mowing.

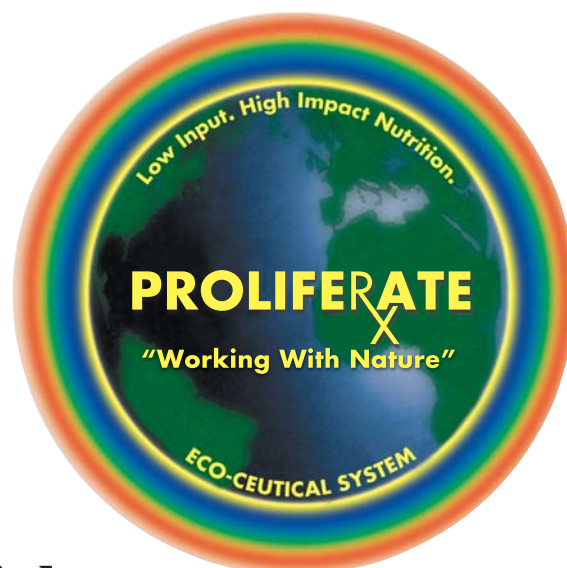
