Application flexibilty


NativeKlean offers a wide application window and can be applied in spring or fall. NativeKlean is rainfast within two hours and does not need supplemental irrigation. It has limited mobility in soil. Apply NativeKlean with equipment that ensures a coarse low-pressure spray, at the recommended rate of 2 pt./A once a year in the fall or spring. Do not apply more than 2.1 pt./A (34 fl. oz.) per year.

NativeKlean can be tank-mixed with Turflon® Ester Ultra specialty herbicide to increase the spectrum of control on woody species. It can also be tank-mixed with Dimension[®] specialty herbicide for preemergence weed control of grassy weeds, including crabgrass.

STEWARDSHIP GUIDELINES

NativeKlean is labeled for use only in native areas or naturalized areas on golf courses that are not regularly mowed or maintained. NativeKlean can be used to treat broadleaf weeds up to water's edge. Additional application guidelines include:

- Do not apply this product on golf course fairways, roughs, greens or tee boxes; home lawns; athletic fields or similar areas.
- Do not apply NativeKlean within a distance equal to the height of the tree or plant.
- Do not apply around trees or desirable broadleaf vegetation (e.g., wildflowers). Applicators must maintain a buffer around trees to prevent root uptake.
- Do not spray NativeKlean within 250 ft. of residential properties.
- Do not use vegetation clippings treated with NativeKlean in composting; clippings treated must remain on-site.
